Amendments to the bye-law of Indian Veterinary Association, Kerala

(as passed by the General Body on 27.12.97 at Palakkad)

Member

5. Mode of admission: Every application for membership be made to the General Secretary of the Association in the prescribed form together with the subscription and admission fees. He shall then place it before the Executive Committee for decision. The power to admit, refuse or readmit vests in the Executive Committee.

The admission fee will be Rs.50/- This amount will be retained by Taluk units enrolling the members.

Subscription: The Annual subscription, which shall always be payable in advance, shall be Rupees 200/- Members in arrears of subscription for over one year shall cease to be members of the Association. Such members are eligible for readmission only after payment of admission fee as a new member. Every member shall pay an admission fee of Rs.50/- at the time of enrolling.

Out of the subscription of Rs.200/-collected, the Taluk Units will retain Rs.15/- and District Units will retain Rs. 35/- and the remaining Rs.150/- will be handed over to the State Committee through the District committee.

8-A District Units.

- i) All districts have a unit of the Association
- ii) The District Units shall consist of the following elected office bearers.
 - a) President b) Secretary
 - c) Treasurer d) Executive Committee Member e) President and Secretary cum Treasurer of Taluk Units.
- iii) All rules and byelaws formulated for the state committee shall be applicable to the District Units and Taluk units unless otherwise specifically mentioned. District units and Taluk unis can have bank account jointly operated by the President/Secretary and Treasurer with annual auditing system by elected audiors.
- B. i) Association will have Taluk Units in each Taluk
 - ii) Taluk Units will have President and Secretary
 - iii) Taluk Units will be responsible for enrolling new members and collection of subscription.
 - iv) District Units will initiate action for formation of Taluk Units. Till formation of Taluk Units, present system of fuctioning will continue.
