### **WYNAD**



## TEST TUBE FOAL BORN IN EUROPE

Even though test tube horses were born at United States and Australia, Europe's first test tube foal was born as part of a program to create stronger and faster horses for show jumping and eventing teams. This could help in conservation of rare breeds and may open the door to genetic modification and cloning. It will not be used in horse racing as international rules governing the sports ban artificial insemination and invitro fertilization. An embryologist from China, Dr. Xihe Li created test tube foals at the equine fertility unit in Newmarket using intracytoplamic sperm injection techniques.
