Mukundapuram taluk IVA unit celebrated World Zoonoses Day on 6.07.01 at Chalakudy. Conducted seminar for college students.






dent, Perambra, presided over by Dr. M.M. Mathai. Dr. P.K. Muhsin, DAHO of Kozhikode, distributed the prizes.
